

SCHOOL UNIFORM CODE

Parent/guardian cooperation to enforce the dress code is essential. Parents/guardians should be aware of appropriate apparel and overall appearance, and should see that their children leave for school looking their best within modest limits.

ALL GRADES	
Blouses/Shirts	
Shirts are collared polo shirts in the designated colors for gender and/or grade level. Shirts must be tucked in. Dry fit material is permitted.	
Sweaters	
Solid navy sweaters or pullovers may be worn over shirt. No oversized sweaters or emblems (outside of spirit wear) may be worn.	
Sweatshirts	
Only school uniform or solid navy-blue sweatshirts may be worn in the classrooms. Uniform spirit wear sweatshirts can be purchased from the online spirit wear store.	
Socks and Leggings	
Only solid navy, black, or white socks may be worn. Girls may wear solid navy or black ankle length leggings with socks in cold weather under the uniform skirt or jumper. White tights with feet are permitted.	
Shoes	
Dress or gym shoes may be worn. Shoes with any type of closure must be fastened. Shoestrings must be laced and tied. No sandals or other open shoes are allowed.	
Make up, Jewelry, and Accessories	
Makeup of any kind is not allowed. Any form of jewelry that is distracting is not permitted. For example, a simple cross or religious medal may be worn on a simple chain. One simple ring may be worn on a hand. Temporary or permanent tattoos are not permitted. Hats or scarves may not be worn in the building except for special, announced occasions.	
Hair and Grooming	
Hair must be clean and neatly groomed. No extreme or distracting hair colors or styles are permitted.	

GIRLS UNIFORM K-5	
Polo	
	Navy blue or white long or short-sleeved polo may be worn. This should be tucked in. The collar must be visible underneath a sweater or sweatshirt.
Plaid Jumper or Skirt	
	Uniform skirt or jumper should be a modest length (Mid-thigh or longer). Shorts may be worn under the skirt jumper but may not hang below the skirt.
Pants	
	Navy blue twill dress pants only.
Shorts/Skorts	
	Navy blue twill, or uniform walking shorts may be worn. Shorts and skorts should be a modest length (Mid-thigh or longer). Uniform plaid or navy skorts may be worn all year and with tights or leggings during winter months.
GIRLS UNIFORM 6-8	
Polo	
	white, navy or dark green long or short sleeved polo with a round or pointed collar.
Pants	
	Navy blue or tan khaki tailored dress pants only.
Shorts/Skirts/Skorts	
	Navy blue twill, or tan khaki uniform walking shorts may be worn. Shorts, skirts and skorts should be a modest length. Uniform plaid skirts must be a modest length (Mid-thigh or longer). Navy or uniform plaid skorts may be worn all year and with ankle length tights during winter months.
BOYS UNIFORM K-4	
Polo	
	Light blue or white polo with long or short sleeves.
Pants	
	Navy blue twill dress pants only.
Shorts	
	Navy twill walking shorts may be worn.
BOYS UNIFORM 5-8	
Polo	
	Light blue or white polo with long or short sleeves.
Pants	
	Navy blue twill or tan khaki dress pants only. Pants must be worn at the waist. Trendy and cargo pants are not considered dress pants.
Shorts	
	Navy twill, or tan khaki walking shorts may be worn.

Out-of-Uniform Dress Code Policy

Frequency of Out-of-Uniform Days:

- Out-of-uniform days will be designated periodically throughout the school year, typically on special occasions or as a reward for meeting specific criteria.

Appropriate Dress:

- Students are expected to dress in a manner that reflects modesty, respect, and good taste. Clothing should be clean, in good repair, and free from offensive language or graphics.

The following guidelines apply to all out-of-uniform attire:

- Tops: Shirts, blouses, or sweaters with sleeves that completely cover the shoulder. Tank tops, halter tops, and spaghetti straps are not permitted.
- Bottoms: Pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses of appropriate length (no shorter than mid-thigh when seated). Leggings may be worn under dresses or skirts.
- Footwear: Closed-toe shoes or sneakers. Sandals, flip-flops, or high heels are not permitted for safety reasons.
- Accessories: Hats, caps, or head coverings are not permitted indoors.
- Jewelry: Minimal and non-distracting jewelry is allowed. Excessive or oversized jewelry is discouraged.

School Spirit and Themes:

- On certain out-of-uniform days, students may be encouraged to dress according to a specific theme or to show support for school spirit events. Guidelines for appropriate attire will be communicated in advance.

Guidance from Parents/Guardians:

- Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that their child's out-of-uniform attire complies with school guidelines. Students who arrive dressed inappropriately may be asked to change into appropriate clothing provided by the school or return to their uniform attire.

Consequences for Violations:

- Students who violate the out-of-uniform dress code may be subject to disciplinary action, including a warning, loss of out-of-uniform privileges for future events, or other appropriate consequences as determined by school administration.
